Mohyla Academy

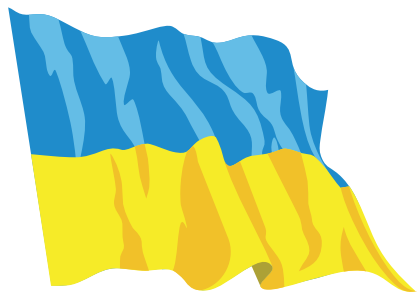


The Mohyla Academy was re-established in 1991 after Ukrainian independence. The Academy was founded by Metropolitan Petro Mohyla in 1632.

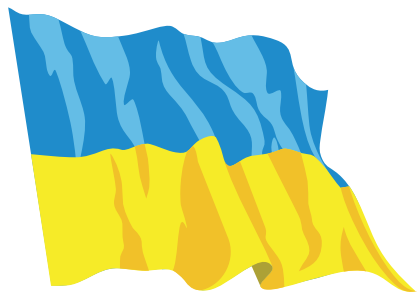

Narbut Definitive Set



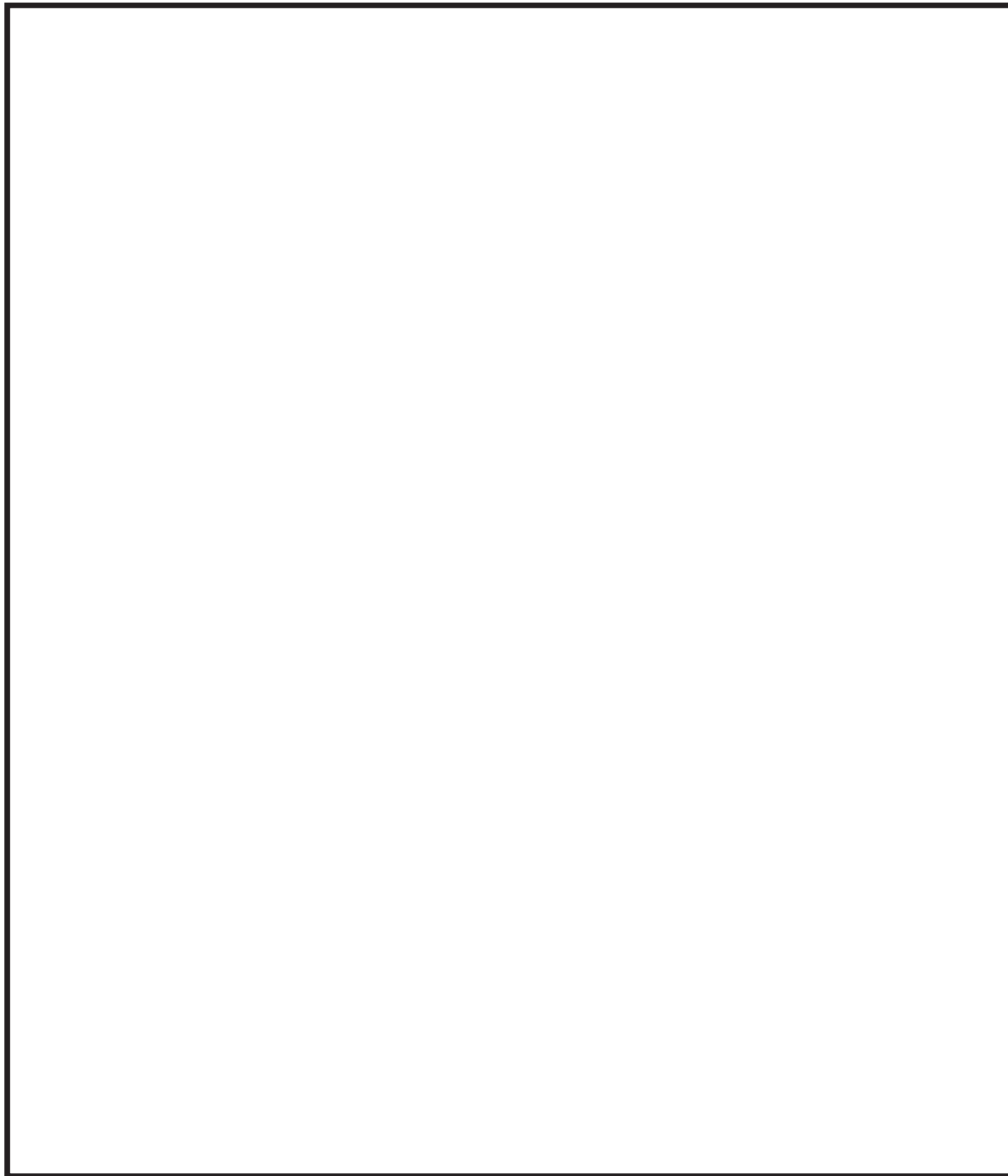
The Narbut Definitives were based on the design of H. Narbut's 30 Shahiv stamp that was issued in 1918 by the Ukrainian National Republic.

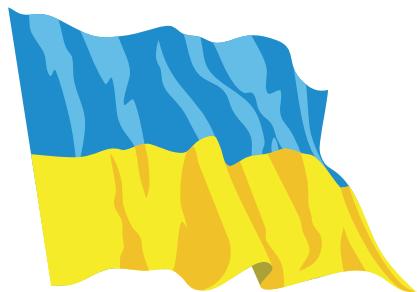
