Lviv Coat of Arms



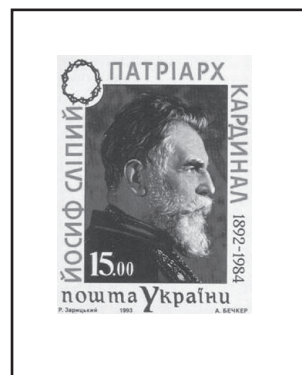
The coat of arms of Lviv, the ancient capital of Western Ukraine is shown here.

This stamp celebrates the liberation of Kiev from Nazi occupation during World War II. The stamp shows Kiev's main boulevard during WWII and then rebuilt.

UN Declaration of Human Rights

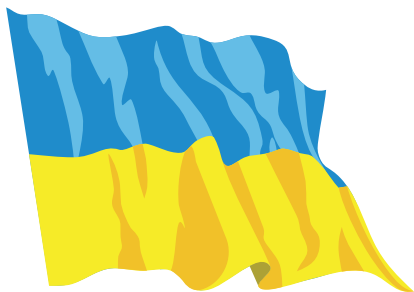


This stamp was issued to celebrate the 45th anniversary of the United Nations Declaration of Human Rights.

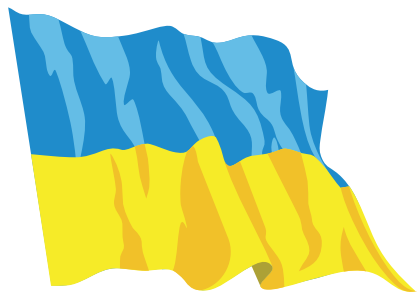

Rural Life Definitives



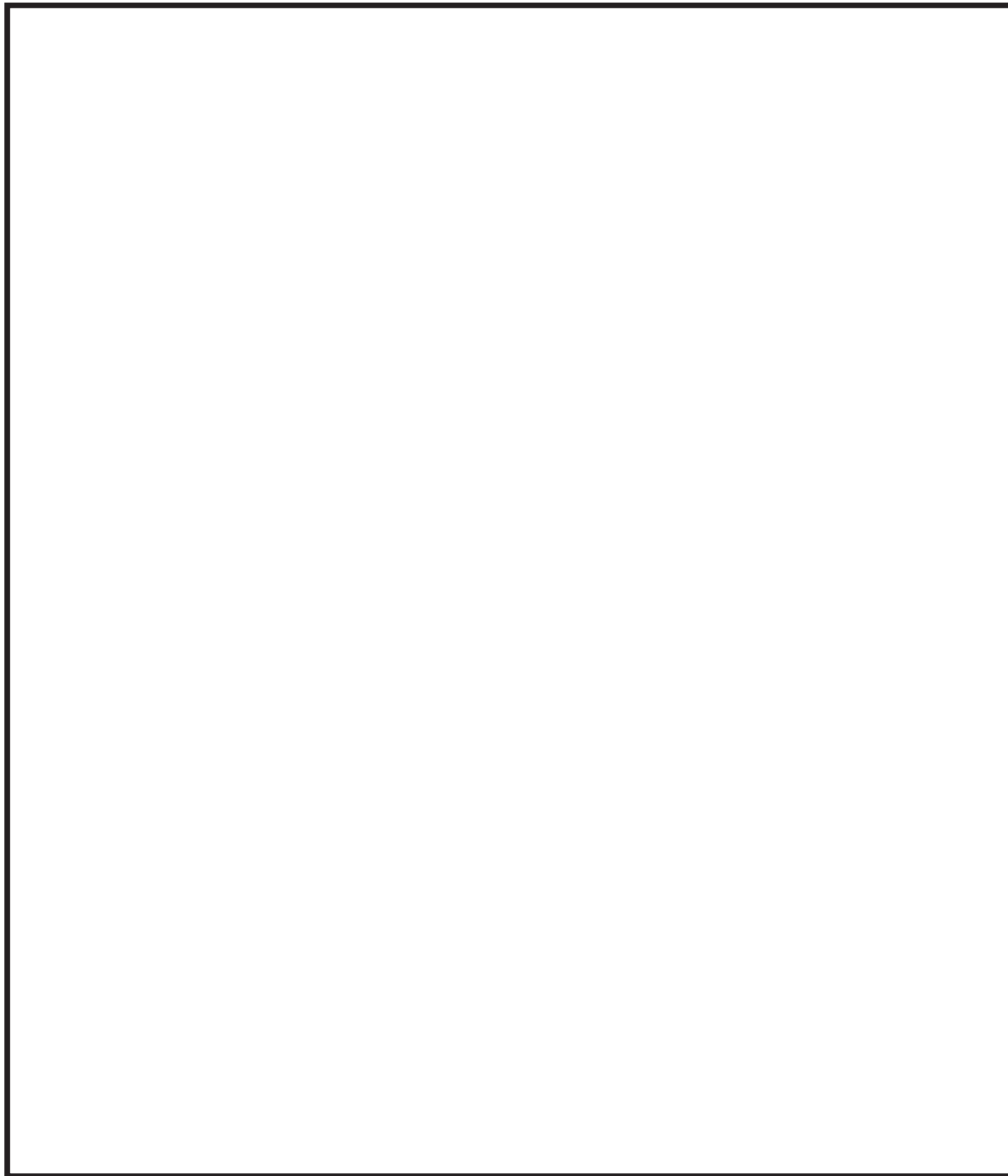

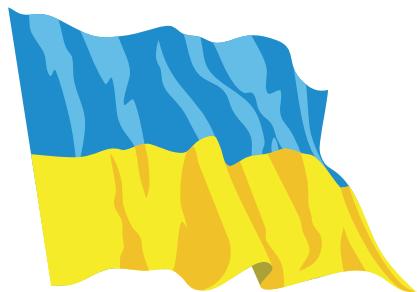
